


What should be your priority?

BIG LIE #1



YOUR SEXUALITY IS YOUR IDENTITY

This is a dangerous lie, even in traditional heterosexual relationships. Many marriages have been negatively affected when one partner feels rejected by the other over matters of sexuality. When they believe their sexuality is their identity, then rejection becomes personal and wounding. Therefore, when sexual confusion is present, this lie can be even more wounding.

BIG LIE #2

YOUR SEXUALITY IS STAGNANT

We are often led to believe that our sexuality never changes, that it is hardwired. But sexuality is incredibly nuanced. Hormone shifts and life experiences can change how any person will relate to sexuality and desires. And research has shown that when these hormones are fresh or peaking, sexual desire can be very different than at other times, including what we hold as the object of our desires.

BIG TRUTH

YOU ARE MORE THAN YOUR EVER-CHANGING SEXUALITY, SO TALK ABOUT THE "MORE"

Even in the secular mindset, we have to recognize we are more than our sexuality. We have hobbies, likes, dislikes, careers, friends, passions, and more - most of them unrelated to our sexuality. And when we recognize that our true identity is found in Jesus, then life can be very rich.



SEPARATE LIES FROM TRUTH

WHEN DISCUSSIONS OF SEXUAL IDENTITY ARISE WITHIN A FAMILY, THERE ARE OFTEN HARD LINES DRAWN BY ONE OR MORE FAMILY MEMBERS. THESE HARD LINES HURT AND PUSH PEOPLE AWAY FROM EACH OTHER, AND OFTEN AWAY FROM GOD. IT IS IMPORTANT TO RECOGNIZE THE BIG LIES THAT THESE HARD LINES ARE BASED UPON AND TO TRANSITION THE CONVERSATION FROM THE BIG LIES TO THE BIG TRUTHS.
