New York Conference Trail Blazer Award

- 1. Must be a New York Conference teen Pathfinder.
- 2. Must fulfill all requirements for Pathfinder of the Year for this Pathfinder year.
- 3. Must participate in one teen activity this Pathfinder year.
- 4. Must participate in one work project (teen activity, if possible, or local club other than the Club of the Year project) working at least 8 hours.
- 5. Help plan and carry out a fund raising activity, raising at least \$30 per person, and give the money to a worthy cause. (Might be used for group work project #4 above, Ingathering, Investment, Jerry's Kids, March of Dimes, orphan sponsorship, etc.).
- 6. Help plan and participate in an ecology or conservation project (other than your special project for the year), spending at least 8 hours on it.



- 7. Obtain or maintain a Good Conduct Ribbon for the current Pathfinder year.
- 8. All the above requirements must be completed within a 12-month period.
- 9. Must be present, in Class A uniform, and pass inspection by the Conference Pathfinder Director at the time award is presented, to receive this award.
- 10. Pathfinder may earn this award for each year in which all the requirements are fulfilled.
