

New York Conference Trail Blazer Award

1. Must be a New York Conference teen Pathfinder.
2. Must fulfill all requirements for Pathfinder of the Year for this Pathfinder year.
3. Must participate in one teen activity this Pathfinder year.
4. Must participate in one work project (Teen activity, if possible, or local club – other than the Club of the Year project) working at least 8 hours.
5. Help plan and carry out a fund raising activity, raising at least \$30 per person, and give the money to a worthy cause. (Might be used for group work project #4 above, Ingathering, Investment, Jerry's Kids, March of Dimes, orphan sponsorship, etc.).
6. Help plan and participate in an ecology or conservation project (other than your special project for the year), spending at least 8 hours on it.
7. Obtain or maintain a Good Conduct Ribbon for the current Pathfinder year.
8. All the above requirements must be completed within a 12-month period.
9. Must be present, in Class A uniform, and pass inspection by the Conference Pathfinder Director at the time award is presented, to receive this award.
10. Pathfinder may earn this award for each year in which all the requirements are fulfilled.
